We hereby announce that our Board of Directors has resolved at a meeting held today to distribute dividends from surplus with a record date of March 31, 2026, as follows

2. Reason

The Company's basic policy is to strengthen its financial structure and distribute the outcomes in a manner that reflects its business performance. In principle, the Company will pay dividends based on either a full-year dividend payout ratio of 45% or an annual dividend of 80 yen per share, whichever is higher. Based on this policy, the Company resolved to increase the dividend by 6 yen from the previous forecast to 58 yen per share (annual dividend of 86 yen per share), and the effective date of the distribution of surplus is June 4, 2026
